## What is Batten Disease?

- Batten Disease is a rare, fatal, inherited disorder that primarily affects the nervous system.
- It is a genetic autosomal recessive disorder.
- There are 14 known types of Batten Disease.
- The Rare Sisters suffer from CLN3, Juvenile Batten Disease.
- It is estimated that there are 14,000 people currently living with Batten Disease in the world.
- Symptoms of Batten Disease include blindness, seizures, behavioral changes, dementia, mobility loss, and premature death by late teens to early twenties.
- There are currently no treatments or cures for Batten Disease.
- Batten Disease may be rare, but neurodegenerative and genetic diseases are not. Alzheimer's, Huntington's, Parkinsons, Dementia, and Batten are all linked.

## The Rare Sisters

RSBF was inspired by sisters Cecilia & Lilly who were 8 & 6 years old when they were diagnosed with Juvenile Batten Disease.



## Our Mission

Support medical research for treatments and cures.



RSBF has granted \$50,000 to the founding and ongoing work of the BNDC at CHC. This Batten-specific clinic allows families to meet with multiple specialists in one visit.

Profoundly help families diagnosed with Batten Disease with monetary assistance to offset the major expenses that come with this diagnosis.



RSBF has provided 19 grants to Batten families, totaling over \$250,000. These grants have provided needed support for families whose daily lives are significantly impacted by Batten's Disease.

Funding requests are endless. We hope to continue to fund the Children's Hospital Colorado Batten Clinic and fund the numerous grant applications that come in.


